What To Bring to Your First Visit

On your first visit to Glenelg Orthopaedics, please allow time for parking. There are 1 hour car parks available on the street.

Dr Nimon requires certain information from you to best assist in your treatment and therefore at your first visit you will be asked to complete a Patient Information Sheet and Privacy Consent Form.

Therefore, make sure you bring the following with you;

- Reading Glasses
- Current referral from your GP
- Medicare card
- Pension card
- Private health Insurance card
- An Xrays or scans you may have of the problem area
- List of current medications and dosages
- List of known allergies
- Details of physiotherapy treatment
- Details of relevant medical of operation reports

Remember to wear comfortable clothing that will allow you to expose the joint or limb to be examined.
